THE LABOR MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE EXTENDS REGISTRATION DEADLINE FOR UPCOMING GOLF TOURNAMENT

EDWARDSVILLE, ILL., September 15, 2008... The Labor Management Committee of the Leadership Council of Southwestern Illinois and supporters region-wide are making plans to hit the links Thursday, September 25 to drive in the needed funds to further the work of the Committee. “Our committee has been fortunate enough to rely on state and federal grant money to support our operating costs until recent years,” stated Marv Finkelstein, executive director of the Labor Management Committee, which remains the longest continuously operating labor-management committee in the state of Illinois.

The Labor Management Golf Tournament will be held at the Clinton Hill Golf Club, which boasts some of the largest greens in the Midwest. The cost to enter the four-person scramble is \$100 per golfer and includes lunch, 18 holes of golf, cocktails and a dinner reception. Golfers may register foursomes or sign up individually and ask to be placed in a group. Mulligans will be available for \$5 with a limit of four, and Skins are \$20 per foursome. The tournament begins at 11:00 a.m. with lunch and registration, followed by a shotgun start at noon.

Sponsorship opportunities are available for interested businesses, organizations and individuals. Levels include Hole in One (\$5,000), Double Eagle (\$2,500) and Birdie (\$1,000). Tee Signs can also be purchased for \$100. Sponsorship incentives vary depending upon the level of giving and feature free foursomes, tee sponsorships, marquee signage, inclusion on the Labor Management Committee's website, special recognition and an opportunity to provide company giveaways for the golfer goodie bags.

All monies raised will be allocated towards the work of the Labor Management Committee and its efforts to promote awareness of labor-management cooperation, improve the image of Southwestern Illinois and help it become a region where cooperation is a priority.
